

## District Councillor Report – Sellindge 12 September 2023

I have received a number of emails over the last months over the speed of traffic through the Village, particularly from Barrow Hill residents which is, of course, an ongoing issue. I have been in touch with our local Police Officer and he is hoping to get the Speed Police Control Unit to undertake a few checks in the area.
