## (PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

## **TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

To allow works to be carried out to provide a new fibre connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on sections of Stone Hill and Plain Road, Sellindge / Smeeth.

Off-peak closures are planned from Monday 1 March 2021 for up to 3 days, between 09:30 hours and approximately 15:30 hours each day.

Stone Hill and Plain Road will be closed in phases between the junctions with Southenay Lane and Lilyvale, to the extent shown at any time

The alternative route for through traffic is via Stone Hill, A20 Main Road, Hythe Road, Church Road and Woolpack Hill back to Plain Road.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation, and updated information can be found on www.one.network – [BT Openreach Permit BC008WBMD8J8Y01], with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
