KENT AND MEDWAY SIGN SUPERFAST BROADBAND DEAL

One of the biggest infrastructure projects in Kent's history will start this year as better broadband is delivered across the county by Kent County Council and BT. Announced March 18th, the partnership is backed by £10m of council funding £9.87m from central government and £19.6m from BT. The contract, which is being signed today, follows the enormously successful 'Make Kent Quicker' campaign, which saw thousands of people sign up and say they wanted more from their broadband.

The Make Kent Quicker project was set up to bring broadband to every property in Kent and Medway – and make sure that most will be able to access superfast broadband services. Without this project, many rural business and communities would continue to have either no or very slow broadband services as there are no market-led plans to upgrade infrastructure in many rural parts of the county. Now, the combination of public funding and private investment, alongside existing roll-out plans, will make sure that at least 95% of properties in Kent will have access to higher-speed fibre broadband by the end of 2015 (with 91% having access to superfast speeds of 24mbps and above) – and every property in the project area able to access download speeds of at least 2mbps. Surveyors will be making their way across Kent during the rest of this year with 2014 and 2015 expected to be particularly busy as hundreds of miles of fibre are installed, helping to keep the county connected and competitive.

As a result of this new contract, thousands of homes and businesses in Kent and Medway stand to benefit and the improvement could deliver £1.5bn to the county's economy each year.

Communications Minister Ed Vaizey said: "Kent is now well and truly on the way to providing better broadband access and speeds to the entire county. This project will deliver superfast broadband to thousands of homes and businesses and bring a massive boost to the local economy, as well as making things like gaming, watching BBC iPlayer or downloading films much quicker and hassle-free."

SADDLE UP FOR THE AIR AMBULANCE BIKE RIDE



Life-saving charity Kent, Surrey & Sussex Air Ambulance is appealing for cyclists to join its new-look Double 100 bike ride this summer. The 100-mile or 100km ride on June 23rd will this year start and finish at the Surrey and Sussex helicopter base at Redhill Aerodrome. Both new routes take in all counties covered by the two helicopters and the 100-mile route will pass through Marden in Kent – the home of Kent Air Ambulance. More than 80 riders including Air Ambulance crew members and former patients took part in the inaugural Double 100 from Dunsfold Park, raising £12,000 for the charity.

Organisers are aiming for more than 100 entries in this year's event which has kindly been sponsored by Howard Cundey Chartered Surveyors and Estate Agents, Asda, Warburtons and

Wellbeing People. Howard Cundey Partner Tim Foulkes said: "With a network of offices based around the counties covered by the Air Ambulance, we are delighted to be the main sponsors of the charity's 2013 Double 100.

February weather was predominated by the bitterly cold north-easterly winds blowing from Siberia. Daytime temperatures were 2.96°C below the monthly average and nights were down by 1.49°C. Rainfall over the month was minimal at only 62.98mm (1.63in) including 22.35mm (0.88in) from 7-8 cm of snow that fell on Sunday 10th.
