

The Sellindge Parish By – Election took place on Thursday June 20<sup>th</sup>, the Polling Station was the Durling Hall, which open for voting from 7am to 10pm. Out of an Electorate of 1,350, there 245 voters a turnout of 18.5%.

The result was – Carlton Chislett 161, Christopher Mason 127, Janet Matthews 110 and Patrica Vago 132.

Therefore Carlton Chislett, Christopher Mason and Patrica Vago were duly elected.



Your Council met in June and the meeting was quite short. This was a surprise to those who were present, but this does mean I have more time to carry out the requests of your Council.

Mr Fursdon reported on behalf of the Planning Group, the comments that had sent to Shepway against the development in Lympe on the extension to that area, the main comment being the possible increased traffic for Sellindge.

There were a few more letters sent to your council this month concerning local issues, these were noted as follows

- The problem with lorries parking under both the motorway and railway bridges on the pavement – if you see this do report it at the time using the 101 number, this will take you to the Kent Police call centre and once reported the Police will take action – we hope – if you do contact the Police for this or any other reason do let your Parish Council know as we can monitor this and support residents if no action is taken.
- A complaint about grass not being cut – was an oversight, volunteer doing this had not been given the full details.
- A letter sent to the bus company to have a bus stop outside the Village Hall was referred back to your Council and after some further investigation a request was sent to the Infrastructure Officer Kent County Council who has looked at this and there should be a bus stop with proper raised kerb and post outside the Village Hall soon.

In addition to the extra time I get, not used at meetings, your Council agreed the role of the Clerk required more hours; this has meant that extra work is being carried out and items are now being placed on the website. At this meeting a Complaints Procedure was adopted and this will be on the website soon, if not already and there is a form you can download – if you have access – and complete, if you have a complaint. Alternatively you can come to the office to get one.

Mr Minister is to take over updating of the Action Log; this log, used to monitor items reported to the highways department.

Also held this month was the Annual Parish Meeting or Annual Assembly; this was given a new format which your Council is happy to say the majority of people who attended liked. As this format was so successful – over 20 people attending, rather than the 2 or 3 for a more formal approach, it is expected that the assembly will be held in the same manner next year. Although some people were surprised that there was no ‘formal’ section to the Assembly, everyone had the chance to see what is happening in the parish and could add their name offering to volunteer on various items, or collect dog poo bags.

Plus for the first time a written annual report was produced which was available at the Assembly, for those who did not attend copies are available from your Council Office or the website. It is expected that more groups and organisations can contribute next year, so look out for the request from your Clerk in March 2014 for yours.

Dog Poo bags are now available free of Charge to dog owners; your Council asks that, rather than leave them in hedgerows you place them in any litter bin. These litter bins are emptied by Shepway District Council on a regular basis. And while talking of litter bins your Council has arranged to purchase 3 more – this due to requests from a large number of residents – although your Council will have to cover the cost of emptying these.

The Free of charge dog poo bags can be collected from the Council Office, the Sports and Social Club, and from Sarah-Jane Sandy one of your Councillors who lives in Moorstock lane.

The last but no less important is to congratulate the three new Councillors to the Parish Council and commiserate to the person who was not to lucky to be elected. More details are available elsewhere in the newsletter.

**NEIGHBOURHOOD WATCH** – Your Council has appointed Councillor Colin Minister as the co – coordinator for Sellindge. The main aim is to get as many people as possible to sign up for this scheme. The Village will be divided into 5 zones, being that it would make it easier to manage. With 1 person in each zone being the link person, reporting back to Colin, who then can collate and send the relevant information to the Parish Council or the Police. If any person would like to join, all they have to do is let him know by just leaving your details, either by e-mail to him at [c.minister@sky.com](mailto:c.minister@sky.com) or at the Parish Council office or any other Parish Councillor. Some Insurance Companies also give a discount if you are a member of a Neighbourhood Watch scheme. If any areas of the Village are already formed into NHW group, please let Colin know so that you can be included.

As mentioned last month, I have a Ward Budget of £2,000 which I am able to use to respond to community needs within the ward and to support projects or activities that benefit the community. If I can help any local group who meet the criteria with a small grant please contact me.

I am pleased to report that the proposal to install bollards on the grassed area at Brook Lane (to deter parking) has been short listed and the site will be visited in the next few weeks to assess cost and viability.

Through my Cabinet responsibility for Health and Wellbeing, I have been advised that following a procurement carried out on behalf of the eight clinical commissioning groups in Kent and Medway, non-emergency patient transport services (PTS) will be delivered throughout Kent and Medway by NSL Care Services from 1 July. People who need transport for medical reasons to get to their hospital or clinic appointment will have one number to call – no matter where they live in the county. Patients can find out if they’re eligible for PTS or book an appointment by calling **0843 2 241 888**. The NSL Care Services contact centre is open from 7am to 9pm, Monday to Saturday. It has details of alternative services for patients who are not eligible.

The first new planning strategy for Shepway in more than 15 years, the ‘Core Strategy Local Plan’, has been approved by the independent Planning Inspectorator. Can be accessed at [www.shepway.gov.uk](http://www.shepway.gov.uk) and page 24/25 relate specifically to Sellindge.

Congratulations to Carlton Chislett, Christopher Mason and Pat Vago on being elected to the Parish Council.

## FROM YOUR COUNTY COUNCILLOR

Susan Carey, Member for Elham Valley, Kent County Council

On June 18<sup>th</sup> I went to the Sellindge Annual Meeting and instead of reading out my report, and listening to the village reports, I found a neat booklet of reports from the village organisations, refreshments and the opportunity to talk informally to both Councillors and Villagers including three of the candidates for the Parish Council vacancies. I liked the new format and hope it will be continued for future meetings.

Following the KCC Election I have been appointed to some extra Committees including the one that deals with Economic Regeneration and my very first meeting included an interesting paper about a project for a School for Creative Start Ups to be run from the Quarterhouse in Folkestone. It would be modelled on an already successful project in London set up by Doug Richard of Dragon Den fame. The course would be intensive workshops in Folkestone's Creative Quarter combined with distance learning and implementing lessons learned in between modules as each student launched their own business. You can find the paper on the KCC website (the Economic Regeneration Cabinet Committee 14 June) and if anyone locally is interested in being one of the initial 100 intake then do contact me.

I have also been appointed Chairman of the Shepway Joint Transportation Board which is where the six local County Councillors and six Shepway District Councillors meet to discuss Highways matters. Our next meeting is on July 1<sup>st</sup> and the programme of Highway Works includes works on Moor Stock Lane (from the junction with the A20, Ashford Road to Cock Ash Lane) and Harring Lane. If you'd like to see the full programme of works this year for the Shepway District the papers for this meeting are on the Shepway website.

May was not a good month for weather. With the exceptions of the two Bank Holidays it was either raining or cold. It was the coldest May since 1996 with both night and day temperatures down by over 2°C on May average, but unlike 1996 no frosts were recorded this year. Rain was recorded on 15 days but even so only 60.07% of the monthly average with a total of 41.656mm (1.64in). This was the 4<sup>th</sup> consecutive month with a below average rainfall this year.


