Your Parish Council met in March and April; however there was no report for the March meeting.

In March a retrospective application was discussed and objected to on the ground that the proposal was too close to the boundary of the neighbouring property. Your Council has agreed that work should continue with the Neighbourhood Plan and further information will be made available as this work progresses. Also public meetings and additional consultation will be arranged, so please make sure you check the notice boards, we do have six, two at the Village Hall, one opposite the Church, one at the junction of Swan Lane and the Main Road (A20) and one at the entrance to Meadow Grove.

Under the Localism Act Parish Councils are being encouraged to take on more services from County and District Councils. During March it was agreed in principle that a pilot scheme of employing a village caretaker. This is to be funded from the return of VAT payments. A review to see how successful this has been will take place at the end of the year.

A Spring Clean has been arranged for Saturday May 4th we will meet in the Village Hall car park at 10am returning at 12 Noon. The April meeting was attended by around 5 members of the public. Jenny Hollingsbee the District Councillor gave a short verbal report, she emphasised that potholes should be reported so that KCC so they can arrange to have them repaired.

The Parish Council did not support an application to reduce the height of some trees protected in Barrow Hill, that are protected by a tree preservation order, as the required written arboricultural advice or diagnostic report was not present with application.

The War and Peace show is coming to the Folkestone race course and it was agreed we should ask one of the organisers to come and do a presentation at the next meeting. There has already been an offer for some-one to attend.

The next meeting will be on Tuesday May 14th in the Durling Hall at 7.30pm and will the Annual Council Meeting. This is where the Chairman for the coming year will be elected and other representatives.

One of the requests from the public session was for the budget to be advertised, therefore please see below.

Running costs £4,130.00 – includes phone, stationary etc.

Staff costs £5,169.00 – Clerks salary

ASH DIE BACK - Kent Trading Standards is aware that some rogue traders are incorrectly advising householders that because of the ash dieback disease, the ash tree on their property must be felled or pruned. Chalara dieback of ash, often referred to as ash dieback is a disease of ash trees caused by a fungus. The disease causes leaf loss and dieback in affected trees and depending on the age of the tree can lead to tree death. Tree owners are not required to take any particular action such as felling the infected ash tree, unless a statutory Plant Health Notice has been served on the owner. A Plant Health Notice can be issued by the Forestry Commission or other plant health authority. Once infected, trees cannot be cured, but not all trees die of the infection. Young ash plants can be killed within one growing season of symptoms becoming visible, whilst older trees can survive initial attacks, although they may die after several seasons of infection.

Kent Trading Standards advise consumers to be wary when dealing with traders at their door. Consider carefully whether you want the goods or services offered. If you are considering work in or on your property it is always best to get at least a couple of quotes from traders. You can find reputable traders on the "Buy With Confidence" good trader scheme run by trading standards. Our officers vet all traders on the scheme for trustworthiness and to ensure they comply with consumer protection laws. Alternatively ask for recommendations from friends or family. In most cases if you agree to buy anything costing over £35 from a trader at your door, the law gives you a 7 day "cooling off" period to change your mind. The trader must give you a written cancellation notice if you agree to have any work done. Failure to give this notice is a crime. If you agree to have work done and the trader asks you to make out a cheque in a name not associated with the business or if they offer to take you to the bank to withdraw cash to pay for the work report it to Trading Standards via Citizen Advice Consumer Service on 08454 04 05 06.

The cold and sun-less weather from February was once again the predominant feature of March. It was one of the coldest on record, day average temperatures were down by 4.75°C and night by 1.65°C. With the exception of 3 days early in the month sunshine was 28.25 hours down on the monthly average. Rain was recorded on 8 days and snow on 4 days, a total rainfall of 44.754mm (1.762in.), 81.19% of the March average. Not a very Spring-like month.

"Visit to Turkey" was the subject of the Speaker Mr. Mike Brett at the April meeting of the Gardeners, and all those present were kept enthralled throughout the whole talk, which included brilliant illustrations of the flora and fauna of Eastern Turkey on a 12 day visit to the Lake Van and Suphan Mountain area. It was surprising to so many beautiful plants growing in such dry mountain conditions - no trees or grass but countless plants which we also know here but in different forms. Irises, Orchids, Tulips, Geraniums, Fritillarias, Hypericums, Ajuga (yellow - whereas ours are usually blue). Fields of Clover and Primula and Roemeria (which looks very similar to the Poppies we know). Almost all of these plants don't grow as tall as ours but the blooms are much larger. For instance Irises grow to about 9" high but the blooms are 6" tall and across, and in all sorts of variegated colours. The photography was excellent - some great shots of butterflies and one or two birds and other animals. All in all this was an excellent evening's entertainment and it was warmly applauded by all those present.


