CHANCE TO MEET YOUR NEIGHBOURHOOD POLICING TEAM

A new initiative to boost visible community policing has been launched by Ann Barnes, Kent Police and Crime Commissioner. During her election campaign, it was one of Mrs Barnes' main manifesto promises to introduce a fleet of 'mobile police stations' – and this pledge has now come to fruition with the introduction of Police Contact Points. These are mobile police vans manned by Police Community Support Officers, which travel around mostly-rural parts of the County where it was felt that police presence needed a boost. The Police Contact Points allow members of the public to report crime or anti-social behaviour, discuss policing issues or concerns, and meet members of their neighbourhood policing team.

Each of the Police Contact Points will make their visits on a two-weekly basis, spending 90 minutes in each location. The Police Contact Point for Sellindge will visit on Sunday September 8th and 22nd from 6pm – 7.30pm, at Village Hall, Sellindge. For more information, visit; www.kent-pcc.gov-uk

Your Parish Council met on August 13th, with a shortage of Councillors due to various reasons. With two of the apologies coming from the Chairman and Vice Chairman, Nigel Fursdon stepped in to Chair the meeting.

Around 18 members of the public were present. All wished to voice their opinions on various issues in the village. A request that posters were not placed on the new bus shelter was made. Although it is impossible to inform people living outside the village, if you live in the village please do not put anything on the walls of any the bus shelter, there are five notice boards in the village and if you drop your notices off at the Council Office, or hand them to any Councillor they will be placed in the Notice boards as space becomes available.

Also requested was that the two mis-matched seats are replaced by a new one that matches the notice board and the new shelter. This will need to be considered at a later date.

When The Chestnuts was built money was put aside for some traffic calming. This money is held by Shepway District Council. Last year your Council was contacted with the suggestion that a traffic island should be placed at the junction of Swan Lane and the A20. After various inspections and conversations with the Highways Department it was agreed that this would not solve any traffic problems and may even add to them and nothing was done. During the debate on this it was agreed that as your Clerk, I would look into requesting that SDC use the money on a different project in the Village.

The issue of Otterpool Quarry was as ever a contentious item. Countrystyle have submitted details on three of the 37 conditions required by either the KCC or the Environment Agency. The planning group will be looking at these details. Also to be considered is the alternative application for Bernhurst. Comments to the Kent County Council and District Council respectively will be sent.

Susan Carey was in attendance and gave a verbal report, however as she always submits her own report for the Newsletter I will say no more here.

Do contact either Graeme or Sue our Community Warden if you have any issues you would like considered. Inappropriate parking continues to be a subject for numerous complaints. Send registration numbers – and photos if you can get them – of the vehicles to the PCSO, Community Warden or even the Parish Council Office, any of us will be able to pass these on to the relevant authorities.

Also mentioned by one of the Councillors was information on the Mobile Police Contact Point. This is a police van that visits every other Sunday evening; the next is on August 25th. This date will have passed by the time you read this, but the one after that is September 8th at 6.00pm to 7.30pm in the car park of the village hall.

Do go along as it was noted if this is not used then the project will be cancelled. (This may be where you can drop off your photos and lorry registration numbers).

For those of you who were at the August meeting, apologies were given by the Chairman, these were reported at 'personal reasons', I can now report that since the Parish Council meeting, Jim Bryant has resigned from being both the Chairman and as a Councillor. This will be made official at the next Parish Council meeting. Having only been a Councillor for a short while, he has worked tirelessly for the Parish in carrying out work that otherwise would have cost a considerable amount of money. It will now be down to those who are left to take up his mantle.

The Parish Council meets in the Durling Hall, at 7.30pm, next on the September 10th, see you there.

SPEED WATCH

Sellindge and Lympne Parish Councils are investigating, purchasing a Speedwatch Speed Camera, this will be funded equally by both the Parish Councils. This way the Speedwatch Speed Camera will be owned by both Parish Councils. The Speed Camera will be operated by volunteers, who will first be given training by Kent Police.

It's a case that one Parish would be using it for a week or so, then the other Parish.

Would you like to become one of the team of Sellindge volunteers, it will not take up much of your time, in fact the more volunteers the better as it will take up less of your spare time. FROM YOUR KCC COUNCILLOR Susan Carey, Member for Elham Valley, KCC – 01303 670 561 As expected, Countrystyle have begun to put forward the information they need to fulfil the 37 conditions attached to their planning permission for the Anaerobic Digester (AD) and Materials Recycling Facility (MRF) at Otterpool Quarry starting with the MRF. This is publicly available information on the KCC website and anyone may send in comments. Unsurprisingly, the first conditions that are being dealt with are the simpler ones to do with the fencing, external lighting and the weighbridge and office. Far trickier will be the conditions concerning present contamination on the site and how this will be cleaned up.

I was at the Parish Council meeting on August 13th where the Countrystyle conditions were discussed. The Parish Council is a consultee, which means it is told about the conditions and may comment but it has no power to agree or refuse any of them. It is the KCC planning officers who will scrutinise the conditions and they will do so very carefully to make sure that any decision can be defended at a planning appeal, in a court of law or to the local government ombudsman. The Environment Agency also must agree before operations can start and both the KCC planners and the EA know that local people, and I as your representative are keeping a close eye on the process. Let me emphasise, anyone may comment on the conditions, if they raise an issue that is relevant then it will be considered. Another issue discussed at the Parish Council was a joint project between Kent Highways and the Parish Council to provide an extra stretch of pavement beside the village hall to help pedestrians between the car park and the school. We have agreed that it will be funded 50/50 by the Parish Council and from my Member Highway Fund. The design is being finalised and I hope it will be in place this year.

I have been sorry to see the recent turnover in Parish Councillors and the expense of by-elections. I wish the present Councillors well in their role as your most local democratic representatives and will continue to work with them on issues of concern to the village.

SELLINDGE

Having been born in the Village, some 60 years ago, there have been a few campaigns where the villagers have come together as one. One being the Converter Station, which resulted in a reduction of the building height.

Playing Fields – or the Sellindge Sports and Social Club as it is now called. The residents of Sellindge helped raise the funds for this, by collecting waste paper on Sundays, which was stored in a wooden shed on the grounds. There were two members of the Committee who did most towards the formation of the Playing Fields, they were Mr G Walker now deceased and Mr Jack Chislet who remains the only honorary member of the Sports and Social Club. The Sports and Social Club are now attempting to get residents to use the club, which after all is of great benefit to Sellindge, due to the cost of travel to out of the Village to other venues.

The Village Hall Restoration – Most of the money raised for the restoration has come from outside the Village, in the way of Grants etc. Even though the Village Hall is owned by the Village and run by Trustees.

There is still a way to go before all the work is finished, it would have been nice, if the money could have been raised to finish the work to celebrate the Village Hall's Diamond Jubilee and the Village Hall Charity Golden Jubilee.

The Village – We still have many items that still need to be resolved. Lorry Park, Wind Turbines, Housing etc. All these are of interest to the residents of the Village, but what with the Residents Association and the Parish Council always at loggerheads, items are being passed that are of interest to the Villagers, housing etc.

It has come a time that Villagers should start to support the Village of Sellindge and those who were elected and wake up to what is happening around them. It's time to start pulling together again as a Village. Mr Michael Garrod.



The weather in July was the sunniest and driest recorded for July since 2006. Temperatures were up on average by 1 °C and rainfall was the lowest also since 2006. From light rainfall on the 2nd there was no further rain until Monday 22nd and from then to the end of July only four further days with rain. The total rainfall from 6 days was 33.274mm (1.31in) only 54.58% of a July average. Yet again, another month with below average rainfall this year.
