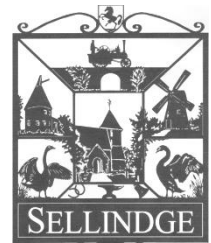

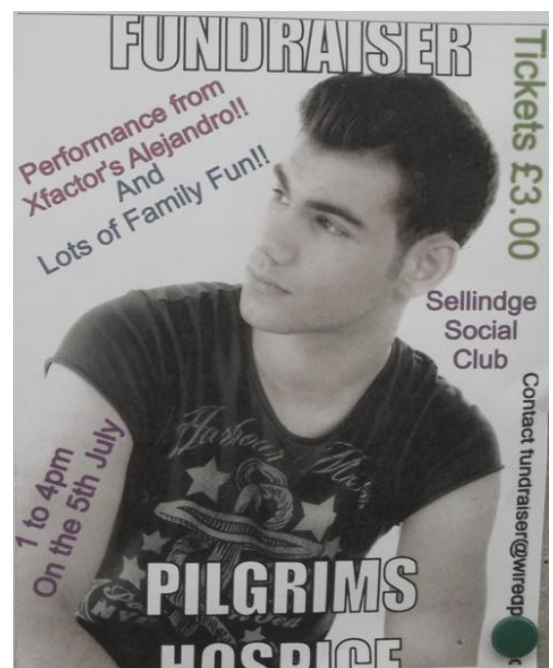

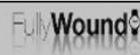

Your Parish Council met on the June in the Durling Hall. All your Councillors were present.

The headings always look much the same, but the content is different. Under Matters arising this month it was reported that the Speed Watch equipment had been out three times during the first two weeks. Lists have been sent to the police. It is hoped that this slows driver down so they will not get letters at all. you have already seen them! Pot holes continue to be a problem in Sellindge, but we must be doing something right as residents from a neighbouring Parish are now sending there pothole information to Colin Minister as we were told 'you seem to get the potholes repaired quicker'.

A short report on the Annual Assembly was made, with Susan Carey stating it was well attended and thinks that others will follow our way. Your Chairman invited the Chairmen of neighbouring Parishes as he along with other Councillors feels that to work with others nearby is the way forward. Also it was noted there were 2 reports which did not make it to the Printing leaflet – apologies for this – however the full report is going to be placed on the website so you can down it in full if you wish.

For planning issues the Vice-chairman took over the meeting as Stan Bull had to leave after having declared an interest in one of the planning applications, he is the neighbour of the applicant. As there was only a couple of applications the Clerk printed A3 copies from the internet which allowed the public and the Councillors the chance to have a look at them before the meeting started.

Sarah-Jane Sandy reported a reduction of dog excrement in Moorstock Lane, this is good news. However we have noticed an increase in people coming to collect their free dog poo bags so if you have not already started doing this then please do. All used bags can be placed in any of the litter bins. Colin also reported a reduction in Greenfields. An amount of litter was reported to have been left in the layby opposite the Co-op. Colin said he would go and collect it in the morning. This takes us on to the Village Spring Clean. Your Council has arranged to carry out a spring clean (Or should I say Summer Clean!?) on Saturday July 26th the weekend after the War & Peace Revival, from 10am to Midday, meet in the Village Hall car park for 9.50 am, watch out for the notices on the notice boards for further details. Also being arranged, the Garden Safari, taking place Sunday 7th September to miss nearby villages activities Your Council next meets on 8th July, so come along and keep up to date with what is going on in the village. There is also a chance to make comments on the items being discussed at the meeting.

At the Cabinet Meeting on 18 June, the application made by Sellindge Parish Council for the approval of a designated "neighbourhood area" that would allow the Parish Council to progress a Neighbourhood Development Plan was agreed.

An item of interest - Confirmation from Kensington Palace that His Royal Highness Prince Harry will be dedicating the Step Short Arch on The Leas on Monday 4 August is excellent news for the District. 200 marshals are needed and they will have the task of ensuring that visitors to the town have a safe and enjoyable viewing experience during this 'once in a lifetime' event to mark the 100th anniversary of the start of the 1914 - 18 war. I will now concentrate on grant opportunities for Communities. One of the core objectives of Shepway District Council is Community Engagement. The Community Chest helps local groups to run projects with lasting benefits. It is open to not-for-profit groups including registered charities, community sports clubs, and other similarly constituted groups based in and working for Shepway residents. There is also the Colyer Fergusson Charitable Trust and they are keen to make grants to support 'young people with poverty of opportunity'. At a recent meeting we were asked to 'spread the word' about this trust as they are prepared to help young people with equipment, etc to pursue their potential. See www.cfct.org.uk

I also have a small Ward grant of £1,000 and local groups are welcome to contact me for further details. Another Scheme, just announced is 'Up on the Downs' a Small Grants Programme to compliment the main grants scheme. Small grants are available for up to £1000 and they have a streamlined application process. All that is required is to speak to the Grants Officer to discuss your project and to fill in a short application form explaining what you plan to do and how much it will cost <http://uponthedowns.org.uk/Grants/Grants.aspx>

Finally, I had the pleasure of opening the Summer Fayre at Sellindge Primary School. Many congratulations to the School Association and Staff for all their hard work. It was a lovely sunny afternoon, enjoyed by all and I hope raised lots of money.

BULLS LANE

Do you know where Bulls Lane is ?
Not many people do ?

At the start of the present Parish Council, back in 2011, a resident from Bulls Lane came to the Parish Council, with concerns that there was no indication as to the name of the Lane that they lived in, which is off the Main Road, nearly opposite Moorstock. At first there was confusion as to the name of the Lane, both the resident and the Parish Council thought it was called Bull Lane. Shepway and KCC both stated that all their records stated it as Bulls Lane.

There were various correspondences between the Parish Council, Shepway and KCC over the years to try and get the Bulls Lane name plates installed.

Then suddenly on Tuesday June 24th 2014 two slightly confused Shepway employee's came to the Parish Council Office, asking where Bulls Lane was, as they had name plates to install.

The Chairman directed them to Bulls Lane, and now the name plates are in place.



FROM YOUR KCC COUNCILLOR Susan Carey, Member for Elham Valley, KCC – 01303 670 561

I was delighted to see the report in the last issue of Sellindge Village News about Speedwatch. I was able to join the first session in Sellindge on 27 May and was pleasantly surprised at the many 'thumbs up' and smiles we had from passing drivers. It's all too easy to focus on those who behave badly by speeding, littering or other antisocial behaviours and forget that the vast majority of people behave well. The drivers who welcomed our presence also care about stopping speeding. Just the sight of a few people in high visibility vests seems to have a beneficial effect on traffic speeds.

Speedwatch volunteers across Kent record the details of vehicles going over the speed limit and send them to Kent Police so they have information from dozens of communities. Warning letters are sent to those who speed and the Chief Constable, Alan Pughsley, has promised that where Speedwatch identifies persistent problems his force will back up the Speedwatch sessions with sessions by the traffic police. However, I have always seen Speedwatch as a way of reminding drivers that they are passing through communities and the aim is to educate rather than punish. A couple of hours a month is all it takes to make a difference so please contact the Parish Clerk if you'd like to get involved.

I was able to join the Parish Council for its meeting on 10 June where the idea of a one way system for Greenfields was discussed. Such a scheme would need illuminated signs as well as all the legal notices so would be costly. No decisions have been made yet and any scheme would require public consultation. If you have views on this then do let me know.

Finally, you may have heard reports about the Government's plans for schools to offer all children in KS1 and reception classes a free meal from September this year. When I was at school (forty years ago) everyone had school meals but over the years more and more children have packed lunches and most schools no longer have the kitchens or dining space room to provide meals for every child. KCC is therefore co-ordinating a scheme to expand kitchen facilities and Sellindge is one of the schools that should benefit and be able to offer school meals to present pupils (and to the extra pupils if the school expands as expected).

Speed Watch - Volunteers and myself have been in various locations. It is already proving effective at slowing vehicles down. There will be another short training session soon if you would like to take part. July 17th at 1800 (6pm) is the planned date and time, venue to be confirmed.

You will not be expected to attend every day just one or two sessions a fortnight. Training is a short 45-60 min session to cover health and safety and the use of the equipment. Please contact me if you would like to attend. Hedges and trees get overgrown at this time of year, anything growing from your property boundary is your responsibility to keep cut back away from the footpath.

Across the District there have been a spate of shed break ins, please be on your guard and keep your sheds locked and secure also your home, locking doors and windows when not at home.

Again across the district vehicles are being broken into especially commercial vehicles, park in well-lit roads try not to leave anything on display.
