SELLINDGE DEVELOPMENT PLANS

The Sellindge developments Plans have now been received. It is a Hybrid application for the redevelopment of land between the A20 and M20 at Sellindge. Application for Outline permission (with all matters reserved except access) comprising of 200 dwellings, local mixed use centre containing parish offices (sui generis up to 100m2), commercial floor space (A1/A3/A5 uses up to 200m2)together with access form the A20, associated roads, parking, earthworks, open space including attenuation features and landscaping. Full application comprising 50 dwellings, village green and play equipment, access from the A20, associated roads.



Due to space being at a premium in last month's Magazine your Parish Council agreed not to include a report in the August Edition, so here is brief update of the July Meeting.

There were no new applications considered, however there were two decisions reported, these were, 5 Barrow Hill an application for a rear extension was granted by SDC and Pruning of Black Poplars in Lourdes Manor Close.

It was reported that the Audit by the Independent Auditor had been completed and this will now be sent off to the Audit Commission. The report was favourable and the only comment was that the direct debits should be included in the cheque list each month.

Also debated was the purchase of the Mapping system from Pear Technology and this was agreed as it will help with both the Neighbourhood Plan and any future asset management.

Now to Augusts meeting.

The Speed Watch sessions are going very well, I have been able to log a number of vehicles breaking the speed limit. The New Planning applications your Council considered was Meadow Bank, an application for a single dwelling. Your Council objected to this and their reasons will be on Shepway DC website.

The other application is for the 'Hybrid application on land next to the Dr's surgery for the 250 dwellings which was the focus on the Sellindge Future document from last year. To enable residents to see the application and what is proposed your Council has arranged for a Public Exhibition on Saturday 13th September, where it is hoped that representatives from Taylor Wimpey or their agents BartonWillmore will be in attendance. Keep a look out on the notice boards for further information.

Also at that exhibition will be further information about the Neighbourhood Plan. Together some of your Councillors and some of the working group members met at very short notice, a Mr Jim Boot who your Council has agreed to engage to lead the project until December. From that exhibition any details will be considered and a decision will be taken as to whether to continue with a Neighbourhood Plan or to continue with a smaller project called a Community Plan. Mr Boot has carried out a number of both types of projects and is well versed to assist.

Your Council have been able to engage Mr Boot due to a grant obtained by 'Locality' a central government organisation which funds these projects.

An email was received from a young lady called Isobel Barry who is doing a dissertation. She is asking for people to come forward who lived in the village around the time of the HS1 railway and the objections to it prior to being built, if you can help please contact the Clerk at the Council Office and details can be passed to you.

The next PC meeting is on 9th September in the Durling hall and while writing this I note that the evenings are drawing in, summer does not seem that far away but it feels like autumn is here already.

Your Council are pleased to see residents attend the meeting, so do please come along.

By now you would have seen the Speedwatch Team out and about the Village with the Speedwatch equipment. As they have been doing a sterling job in trying to keep our Village safe.

In the two months of operating the following figures are.

June 25th, 26th and 27th this was a trial period to get everyone familiar with the equipment.

July 3rd,10th, 18th and 20th – 21 vehicles logged and 3 letters were sent by the Police for + 50% over speed limit.

July 28th – There were 7 vehicles logged.

July 29th and 30th - 17 vehicles logged, 2 letters sent by Police 1 for + 50% over speed limit and 1 for a 2nd offence. We are still in need of volunteers, so if you could spare an hour once in a while.

The Taylor Wimpey Planning Application Y14/0873/SH for outline planning permission for 200 houses and full application for 50 dwellings has now been submitted and validated by SDC. I know that the Parish Council is organizing a public exhibition so that the final plans can be viewed by residents. Comments on the application can be made to SDC right up until the date of the Development Control Meeting and I understand this is likely to be early December 2014.

On the Children's Play Area at the Sports and Social Club, there has been a problem with Health & Safety issues and a dispute with the contractors about the laying of safety surfaces. Hopefully, this should soon be resolved and the area up and running. A lot of work and fundraising has taken place for this play area and the Committee are keen to get it fully into action.

I have been involved with a number of planning and housing issues for local residents and I am always available to give help and advice particularly on Shepway District Council matters.

Within my Community Role, I have visited the Kent Royal Marine Cadets on their Summer Camp at Reinden Wood Hawkinge, was in the march from The Metropole to the Harbour on the unveiling of the Memorial Arch by Prince Harry, attended the Brigade of Gurka's concert and visited a pilot scheme to give young people not in education, employment or training, the opportunity to gain access to the wisdom and experience of role models from the workplace. This was a very inspiring experience for me to see a group of young lads actively involved in a project which after the first two days produced a chicken house, two stools and house signs all made from chestnut. These products are for sale and if anyone is interested please let me know.

It was fine weather for the litterpick on 26 July and one of the volunteers began a few hours in advance of the main party to avoid the heat. The rest of us topped up our tans and collected several bags of sweet papers, plastic bottles and cigarette litter. I helped with Swan Lane which was not badly littered so we were able to cover ground rapidly. What we couldn't remove was the dirt and small stones that accumulate in the gutter and Shepway District Council arranged for the gutters to be swept in early August, I hope everyone notices just how spruce the village now looks. On 04 August many people took part in events to mark the centenary of the start of the First World War from the big formal events such as opening of the Stepshort memorial arch in Folkestone to individuals participating in turning off lights at 11pm to mark the exact moment Britain declared war.

Both Kent County Council and Shepway District Council gave major grants to the Stepshort arch which is at the top of the road from the Leas to the harbour. It was down this road that millions of troops marched down to the harbour. In those days it was known as Slope Road because it was so steep but after the war was renamed the Road of Remembrance. The Stepshort name comes from the command given to troops on the steep road as a normal march would have toppled them.

The Stepshort memorial arch is modern in style but very beautiful and is lit up after dark. Each Sunday at 7pm till Remembrance Sunday on 09 November a bugler at the arch will sound the last post followed by a two minute silence and then Reveille. The Stepshort project also includes a visitor centre and an education scheme and you can find more information on their website www.stepshort.co.uk

KCC's archive centre houses an extensive collection of documents from the First World War and volunteers have created an online timeline of events in Kent during the conflict. The timeline starts in April 1914 as even before the declaration of war on 04 August there were rehearsals for rescue operations held in Faversham. There's material from across Kent, much from Folkestone which played a major role as the embarkation port for troops going to the Front. July was another very variable month of weather. Sunshine hours were up on average with highs and lows and average temperatures were up 1°C. 27°C (80.6°F) was recorded Thursday 17th followed by a high of 30.25° (86.45°F) on Friday 18th the day ending with the second storm of the month. The previous one on Sunday 13th caused a power cut in many areas of the county. High wind speeds were noted in the first, third and last weeks of July. The wettest day was Sunday 13th with 16.003mm (0.63in) recorded.

The total July rainfall was 83.312mm (3.23in) some 36.66% above month average.

Almost the entire house has been re-decorated both inside and out and having cleared most windowsills and shelves, we now wonder where some things are. Most things have turned up in sometimes unexpected places and we have even found things we had forgotten we had! Jesus talked quite a lot about losing and finding things, reminding us of how much God cares for us. The Christian faith today urges us to think about what we may have lost in the past – a faith for instance that seems to have lapsed. When we find a relationship with God we find out more about ourselves and other people. That is surely a cause for celebration.


