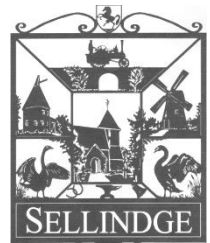

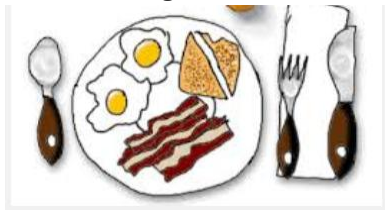

Your Council met on January 14<sup>th</sup>. There was only one planning applications to consider, this was for a new plant store at the rear of the Co-op shop. Your Parish Council supported this application.

From the floor a question was asked about Countrystyle and if there had been any further information, however your Parish Council, like others has not received any further updates at this time.

Colin Minister continues to keep abreast of the pot holes and other things road related so send him any queries direct to his email, which is [c.minister@sky.com](mailto:c.minister@sky.com). This is the same contact for street lights and signs around the parish. He went through the action log of outstanding issues and brought both Councillors and the public present up to date.

Both Jenny Hollingsbee and Susan Carey were in attendance, I'm sure they will be sending their own reports to Nigel. Sue Covus explained that there was a cycle stolen from a back garden, also some tools have been taken from sheds in the allotments. Please remember we have a marker kit in the office to mark your valuables.

Talking of Allotments, some time ago a notice was placed in the newsletter asking if there was anyone that would like an allotment to let the Parish Council know. If you did not reply but now wish to put your name on list contact now.

Sue also reported that a large dog has been seen around the village, if you see it could you contact Sue by email or phone. Her contact details are listed on the information page of the newsletter. Sue along with others has been trying to catch the dog.

One of the replacements seats have been ordered, an issue arriving from the finance working group was the budget and precept. A preliminary budget of £30,406 was considered and agreed by all Council members, but this is subject to the decision from Shepway District Council and the local tax base information to be received after the January 21<sup>st</sup> when they have considered the number of houses at band 'D' equivalent. On the Sellindge website is the report from Action with Communities in Rural Kent. Some of you may remember a questionnaire arriving on your door mat asking about housing. Only 28 people responded. If for any reason you felt that you were not eligible but have some housing problems do send your form in – if you still have it – as consideration is given to everyone who completes and returns form.

There is a consultation at present which ends on February 7<sup>th</sup> about trains stopping at Westenhangar and Sandling. The idea is to reduce the number by half during the off peak period. Your Council is objecting to this, but if you wish to add your own voice then either go to the website of the South Eastern trains and follow the link or the Sellindge website and read the details. The more objections the more chance of saving the service. Three new litter bins have been purchased and installed by the Parish Council at the entrance to Moorstock (A20), at The Dell (A20) and one at Greenfields.

Your Council will next meeting on Tuesday February 11<sup>th</sup> at 7.30pm in the Durling Hall. From your Parish Council Clerk and Proper Office Linda Hedley

**DOG POOP PROBLEM** – Although the vast majority of dog walkers do clear up after their dogs, there does appear to be a Dog Poop problem in the Swan Green / Downs way area. This matter is being monitored, and if it persists, then there is no alternative, but to refer the matter to the Shepway Dog Warden, who has the ability to issue a statutory fine of £1,000. So please do clear up, come to the office and pick up some bags.

Your District Councillor Jenny Hollingsbee and I have always worked closely but since she's taken on responsibility for community engagement at Shepway District Council, we see even more of each other and often find ourselves at the same events several nights in a row. On January 13<sup>th</sup> we met at a quarterly liaison meeting between Kent County Council and Kent County Councillors where school places (including the planned expansion of Sellindge School) and various public health projects were discussed. On January 14<sup>th</sup> we both attended Sellindge Parish Council to make our reports and answer questions. On January 15<sup>th</sup> we were both at the Youth Advisory Group which is another quarterly meeting. YAG brings together all the youth work projects across our district and one of the main items on the last agenda was the Tryangle awards. The Tryangle awards are an annual event organised by young people from Shepway and supported by KCC, Kent Police, Kent Fire and Rescue Service and the Roger de Haan Foundation. Everyone (and this includes you) is asked to nominate any young person they know who deserves an award. Categories include arts, sports and community work. Shepway District Council (i.e. Jenny Hollingsbee) has very kindly given free use of the Leas Cliff Hall for this year's event on June 5<sup>th</sup>. Nominees and their families attend the event which is a bit like the Oscars in format but more fun as the entertainment is also by young people and there are plenty of talented young people in our district. Do please contact me if you would like to nominate a young person or would like to support the event with the offer of a raffle prize.

I am continuing to keep a close eye on progress of the Otterpool Quarry site as Countrystyle seeks to fulfil the conditions it needs to have in place. Progress is very slow as you would expect as the conditions are tough. Speed Watch – are you concerned about the speed of vehicles through your village, would you like to help with Speed Watch Sessions. We are getting reports of a large dog, thought to be large greyhound / lurcher size and grey in colour. We think this dog has been abandoned and has been running loose since the end of November. It does not like human contact and proving very difficult to catch, we know where it likes to stay at night but would like to know where it is during the day. Have you seen it, are you feeding it please let us know if you have. The dog is causing concern as we know it has been hit by at least one vehicle. ### **SELLINDGE SURGERY CARE & SUPPORT'**

Most people know me as the "vampire" of Sellindge Surgery when they come for me to take a blood sample, but I do have other, many other roles at the Surgery which you may not be aware of.

One of them is a project I have recently set up to support people with Dementia and, in particular, their Carers.

I also support elderly, vulnerable people in the community.

The project is called 'Sellindge Surgery Care & Support'.

I have a special interest in the subject of people who care for those with Dementia as well as vulnerable, elderly single people and couples who may not have any family support in the area.

As we get older, our short-term memory often fades. This is not always a sign of Clinical Dementia but if it is, the sooner a diagnosis is made the sooner we can help sort things out, so that the effects of Dementia are minimized as quickly as possible. It is often the families of people with Dementia who suffer the most. It can be very distressing. I speak from personal experience as I lived with and cared for my dad who had severe Alzheimer's Disease.

Because of my own experiences, I am hoping to help others in a similar situation overcome the barriers, and untangle the different strands of care which are available.

I run an appointments clinic on Wednesday afternoons between 2pm and 4pm, which is for assessing people who are at risk of dementia or who feel they may be at risk; for talking with carers who may need to discuss their support and for making telephone calls and home visits to people who require them to discuss issues relating to Dementia, caring or vulnerability. I can refer and direct people to appropriate organisations who may be able to give further assistance and liaise with the GP's and services if it is appropriate. I am always happy to give advice on the subject.

On February 12<sup>th</sup> I am going to give a talk at the Get Together Club meeting in Sellindge Village Hall.

This is to explain more about Dementia and help people to overcome any fears they may have if they are worried about it for themselves or someone else they know. It is also to help people understand the difficulties faced by people who live with Dementia. Dementia is often an age related disease like any other. It is not something to be embarrassed about and with the help of the staff at Sellindge Surgery, it is something which can be managed making life easier for the person with Dementia and the family who care for them.
