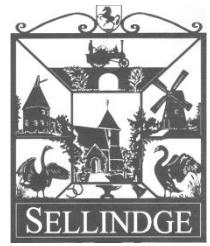

Today I am writing the Parish Council report for the March Issue; it is so lovely to see the snowdrops out at last brightening up the area after such terrible weather.

However, to business! Your Parish Council met on February 11th. Apologies were received from your District Councillor; however a good report is always placed in the newsletter so I am sure there will be nothing you will miss. Susan Carey gave her usual informative update, and I am sure there will be a written report elsewhere in the Newsletter. The Otterpool Quarry condition applications were on the agenda and Nigel presented a report for Councillors to comment on. This will be placed on the website in due course.

There was 3 other planning applications considered and with the help of the projector Nigel was able to show the plans to both Councillors and members of the public present.

It has been noted that many people use the seat at the top of Stone Hill and so it was agreed that a new bin would be purchased to place by the seat opposite the Church. It is hoped this will stop litter being left about there.

Your PC has also agreed to purchase some slabs to make a path by the Village Hall. It is hoped that this can be done soon but again we have to wait for better weather. This will make it safer for schoolchildren and their parents as well as other people to walk from the car park to the school crossing place more safely.

A request for Neighbourhood Watch signs was made; this will be debated at the F&GP meeting when further information will be available.

Also highlighted was whether or not Greenfields should be made one way, this would make it safer for pedestrians and aid the bus getting round the estate. For those who live in Greenfields please do respond to the letter being distributed by the PC. It is not the Parish Council who decides but if there is a majority of residents in Greenfields wishing for it to be one way, then your Parish Council will ask the highways authority to look closer at it.

Not debated at the Parish Council, but to bring you all up to date is about the Neighbourhood Plan. This Committee have considered the questionnaire that will be circulated, updates are required and it needs to be further discussed, before going to print and being circulated. In the future there will be some workshops and other information days to tell you what is going on and how you can get involved.

The next meeting is on March 11th your Councillor's look forward to seeing you there.

As Cabinet Member for Communities, I spend a lot of my time meeting with Voluntary Organisations, attending Health Seminars and sitting on a wide range of different groups. Some of the presentations have included Alcohol Awareness, the effects of smoking on children in confined spaces, House on the Move (Youth Project), Princes Trust, Children's Services and leading two seminars on the Community Compact. This sets out the provisions of the localism agenda in some detail and is designed to help Parish Councils, Voluntary Organisations and individuals in respect of their legal rights. This document can be access at www.shepway.gov.uk . I also met with the Police & Crime Commissioner to hear details of new policing arrangements, soon to be published for our area. It does appear that there will be a move towards more visible policing and a permanent team headed by a Chief Inspector operating out of Folkestone Police Station. She wants to recruit people of all ages to be Special Constables – a minimum of 16 hours commitment per month is required. She has also set-up a fund which local groups can bid into (up to £2,000) – details can be found at www.kent-pcc.gov.uk .

FROM YOUR KCC COUNCILLOR Susan Carey, Member for Elham Valley, KCC – 01303 670 561

This winter's wind and rain have caused damage and misery for many across Kent and I hope that by the time this newsletter goes out the problems are starting to ease. If not, here are some contact numbers that may prove useful:

Kent Highways – 03000 41 81 81 (for surface water and roads and to report potholes)

There's lots of useful advice on the KCC website about how to protect your property and what to do if you have been flooded. The Environment Agency website also has much useful information. The District Council also has a role to play in emergencies and has been supplying sandbags to those at risk of flood.

The damage caused by last winter's snow and this winter's rain has meant KCC has had to use £6.7m of reserves to fund extra repairs. Some repairs need to wait for the water to recede before they can be done but wherever possible a permanent repair is being done now. Please help by reporting problems especially rural roads so nothing is missed. On 11 February I attended Sellindge Parish Council and reported on the latest news about Otterpool Quarry. We are now approaching the third anniversary of Countrystyle receiving planning permission for an anaerobic digester at Otterpool Quarry. This is significant as Countrystyle must start development within three years or the permission lapses. However, before they can start they need to meet several conditions that were stipulated by KCC as part of the planning permission. It's expected that KCC's Planning Applications Committee will consider the conditions at its meeting on 12 March and there's a good chance that Countrystyle may fail to meet the deadline. Countrystyle persisted with their application in the face of great local opposition and there will be much rejoicing if they ultimately lose their permission because they've allowed themselves to run out of time. I shall of course report the result of the meeting in next month's newsletter.

On 13 February the 2014/15 budget was debated at County Hall. The day-long debate was webcast live and is available on the archive at www.kent.gov.uk. After a three year freeze a small rise of 1.99% was agreed. Various amendments were proposed by the opposition parties but none proposed a higher or lower level of rise. It means a Band C household will pay £18.56 extra a year (just under 36p a week) for the KCC part of their Council Tax Bill. This will bring an extra £10m but does not do away with the need for major savings as KCC must make £273m of savings over the next three years.

January and a New Year dawned both wet and windy. This was to be the weather for the rest of the month with rain recorded on 26 days. A total of 181.102mm (7.13in) some 187.5% above the average. It was the wettest January on record both nationally and for Sellindge. Strong to gale force south-west winds were recorded on 12 days and nights. Fortunately not as high as forecast, the worst being on Friday 3rd with gusts to 48.75mph. The temperatures were up by 1.22° day and 1.43° night. Many parts of Kent and the west-country had worst weather than Sellindge.
