

Report from the Annual Parish Council and the Annual Parish Assembly meetings.

On May 5th, your Parish Council held the Annual Assembly for the Parish. As before the Chairman used his allowance to provide some drinks and a small buffet. In the Durling Hall was a representative from the Kent Fire and Safety volunteers, who was able to give advice on fire risks and security, he was kept busy with various people wanting information. We had received a short report from Jim Boot who has been leading the Neighbourhood Plan Group, he produced some graphs to show how people had responded, although since that meeting there have been around another 30 returns, which Jim has said he would be happy to include in the report as he had not completed the final version. It is hoped that the working group will meet soon to discuss the outcomes. The Parish Council had a notice displayed asking for people to put their names forward if they were interested in becoming a Councillor as there are still places to fill. Taylor Wimpey sent a representative, he was from Barton Wilmore, the agent who has worked liaising between Taylor Wimpey, the Parish Council and members of the public and the District Council. For



some of the newcomers to the Village it was nice for them to be able to ask questions and see the plans. The projected start date for the development of the first 50 homes is towards the end of the year. There was also some dog poo bags available to people. All those who attended enjoyed the refreshments and the opportunity to just chat informally to everyone else, it was noted that since the format has been changed, more people attend, this year 25 people attended.

At the Annual Parish Council meeting on Tuesday May 19th, Stan (Pip) Bull was elected as Chairman, with Nigel Fursdon being elected Vice Chairman. The Committee members will be listed on the Website in due course and there will be a paper copy available at the Parish Council Office. The Neighbourhood Plan working Group is now waiting for the full report from Jim Boot the Parish Council Consultant before another meeting is arranged. Their comments and recommendations will then be sent to the Parish Council for consideration and further action.

Our PSCO Nick Hazell sent a report which was read out and he stated that he does visit the village as often as he can, so if you have any worries do not be frightened to approach him.

Do get involved with the Garage Safari, any money raised will be put in the account of the Sellindge Community Fund. This Charity fund was set up to enable local clubs to apply for grants. It also helps if grants are available but that exclude Parish Councils. If you are reading this and are the Treasurer or Secretary of a group in the village do speak to the Clerk of the Parish Council who will send you an application form.

Application forms for the Garage Safari and all the details are on the front page of the Newsletter.

You may have seen the damage to the bus shelter opposite the Dukes Head, this was done by a lorry backing in to the layby. Damage could be seen at the top of the shelter where the contact was made. There was also damage to the lamp post and you may

have noticed that this has been removed. Your Parish Council has not yet decided if it will be replacing the shelter, or claiming on the insurance as at the time of writing there has been no Council or Committee Meeting to discuss this, on the same day, there was

damage done by a lorry to the pavement and kerb in the lay-by at the Church, the Parish Council have requested emergency repairs to this pavement.

On a good note, another litter bin has been provided in Moorstock Lane, it's positioned on the bend by the popular footpath. There are two more planned, one in Swan Lane, by the seat towards the end of the playing field, and one in Brook Lane, both will be installed soon.







And Finally

It is good to see the Bollards on the pavement on both sides of the road underneath the Motor Way Bridge. Your Parish Council approved the purchase of these some 3 months ago to prevent lorries parking and blocking the pavements. As a Parish Council we were not allowed to erect them ourselves, but had to use the KCC agreed contractor, so this increased the price, however members felt it was a price worth paying to prevent the pavements from being blocked and it hopefully will put an end to the rubbish and human waste in the Village.

FROM YOUR DISTRICT COUNCILLORS

Thank you to everyone who voted on 07 May and that's the vast majority of you. North Downs West had the highest turnout (75%) of all the wards in the constituency. This high turnout goes to show that we really do have the most engaged and civic minded residents in the area!

We were delighted to be elected as your two District Councillors and look forward to serving the district for the next four years. We would like to thank all those who voted for us and the team who helped us during the campaign. We tried to see as many of you as we could during the election but there are 5,000 electors in North Downs West so we hope to catch up with more of you in the months and years ahead.

We want to work with the Parish Council but also hope to be involved in all aspects of local life so do please invite us to events and tell us about your projects. We will be working on a 'ward plan' to see what improvements are needed and how we can best support local priorities. There is some money available for grants and, if we can't help you ourselves, we may be able to point you in the right direction.

Shepway District Council is now made up of 22 Conservative councillors 7 UKIP and 1 Labour. The first meeting of the new Council is on 20 May where appointments to committees and special responsibilities are allocated but we are already getting on with work we started before the election particularly with regard to HGV parking and litter.

The elections on 07 May involved almost every part of our elected representatives except County Council where it has been 'business as usual'. However, when we go to the polls for County Council in May 2017 there will be changes. We currently have 84 Kent County Councillors representing just over a million electors (about 13,000 electors per councillor) and you have a chance right now to give your views about the number of councillors and the areas they represent as the Boundary Commission is undertaking a review. The Boundary Commission is proposing to reduce the number of councillors to 81 and with the growth of Kent's population this would mean that there would be one councillor for every 14,288 electors by 2020.

Sellindge would be part of Elham Valley including the parishes of Acrise, Elham, Elmsted, Hawkinge, Lyminge, Monks Horton, Newington, Paddlesworth, Postling, , Stanford, Stelling Minnis, Stowting and Swingfield. The big change is Elham Valley would lose both Saltwood and Lympne parishes as the present division is currently too large with over 16,000 electors.

The main principle of the review is to achieve electoral equality so that each elector's vote carries as much weight as another's. The second principle is to divide the areas up to reflect natural communities and natural borders such as rivers or roads. The Boundary Commission wants comments on its proposals and will listen to representations about the whole of Kent or just parts. The next election in May 2017 will be contested on the new boundaries.

WEATHER FACTS FOR APRIL 2015

Minimum temp. -2.00°C Mon.6th. Mean night temp. 4.23°C Maximum temp. 25.00°C Wed.15th.. Mean day temp. 14.88°C

With only 8 days when any rain was recorded it was yet another year with a dry April. Rainfall was on the first 3 days and the last week of the month. The total was 8.763mm (0.34in.) only 25.36% of the April average.

Day temperatures were up by 2°C in spite of a low number of sunshine hours and night temperatures were near normal. There were only 4 frosts recorded, the last being on Friday 24th.

SELLINDGE CHURCHES - From The Rectory, Mersham.

Dear Friends

After a church service a little boy said to the Vicar 'When I grow up I am going to give you some money' - 'well thank you' said the Vicar, 'but why would you want to do that?'

The boy replied 'Because my daddy says that you are one of the poorest preachers we've ever had.'

We all need to have a laugh from time to time, 'Everyone needs to laugh' according to a health and fitness web site. The sound of laughter is far more contagious than a cough, smile or wheeze. When laughter is shared in binds people together and increases happiness. Apparently Laughter boosts energy, diminishes pain and protects from the effects of stress. Life can be tough and many people have got very little to laugh about. However, in John 16:20 Jesus promises 'your grief will turn to joy.'

Joy is a word rarely used today, yet it must be a fairly important word as it is used over 200 times in the Bible. Joyful is synonymous with 'happy', 'glad' and 'cheerful', but does it mean the same. In the Bible joy may be a state of happiness a special gift related to praise and thanksgiving in worship. 'In your presence there is great joy' says Psalm 16:11, we also read in the Gospel of 'good tidings of great joy'. Jesus enjoyed eating and drinking, which allowed people to accuse Him of being a glutton and a drunk. He enjoyed socialising and being with people.

Jesus was keen to pass on His joy to His followers and to encourage them through sorrow to joy but before they experienced great joy there was great grief and sorrow, the Crucifixion and then the Resurrection. It is so difficult to support people, neighbours, friends through time of sorrow and grief and to lead them forward with joy. However, with the support and fellowship of our caring and loving church we can cause happiness and can direct people to the source of true joy.

To close on an adapted Oscar Willde quote 'Some Christians cause happiness wherever they go; others whenever they Best wishes Ian (Associate Priest – A20 Benefice) go'!
